Hand fitted to create the best there is











The gun moves from one gunsmith to the next to be entirely made by hand, thanks to the expertise acquired over many years by each of the gunsmiths. This is the only shotgun on the market at this price level that is hand fitted during production to such a high

performance level, making each shotgun truly unique. Fitting important parts (barrel, action frame, fore-cud and iron) is done by hand using traditional methods (such as red ochre) so as to make the Browning B525 the reference in shotguns. The attention paid to detail when manufacturing and fitting every Browning B525 is unique, just like the "Browning feeling" when the gun locks on closing.
